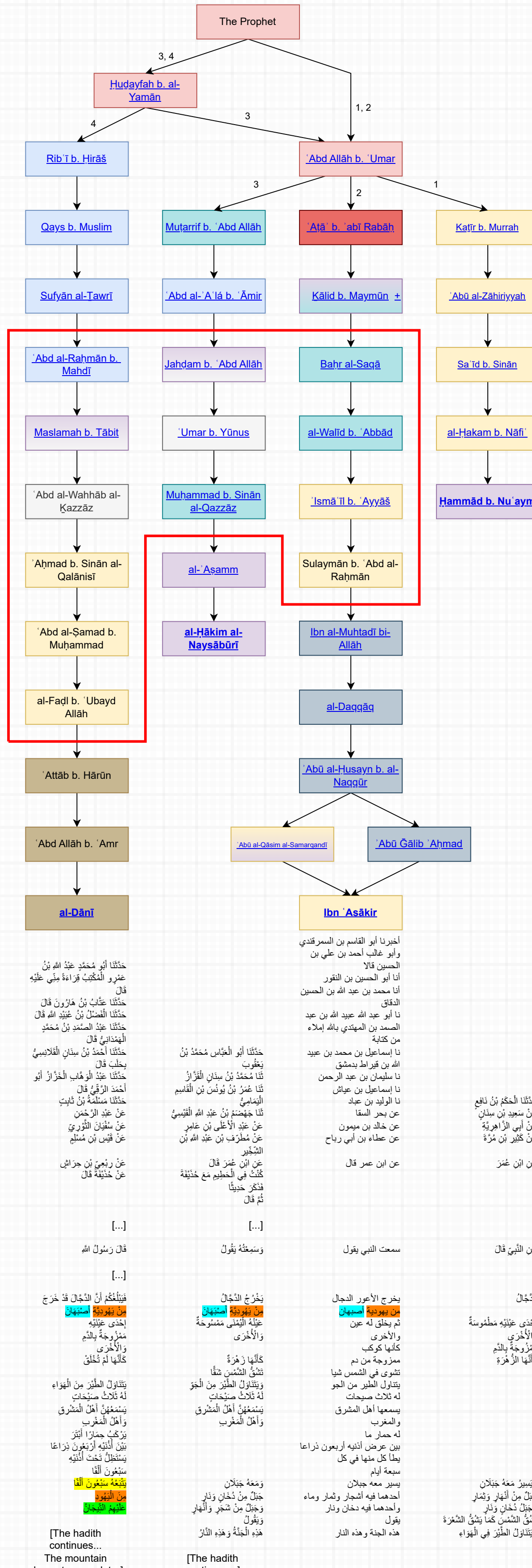

The Antichrist's eye, etc.



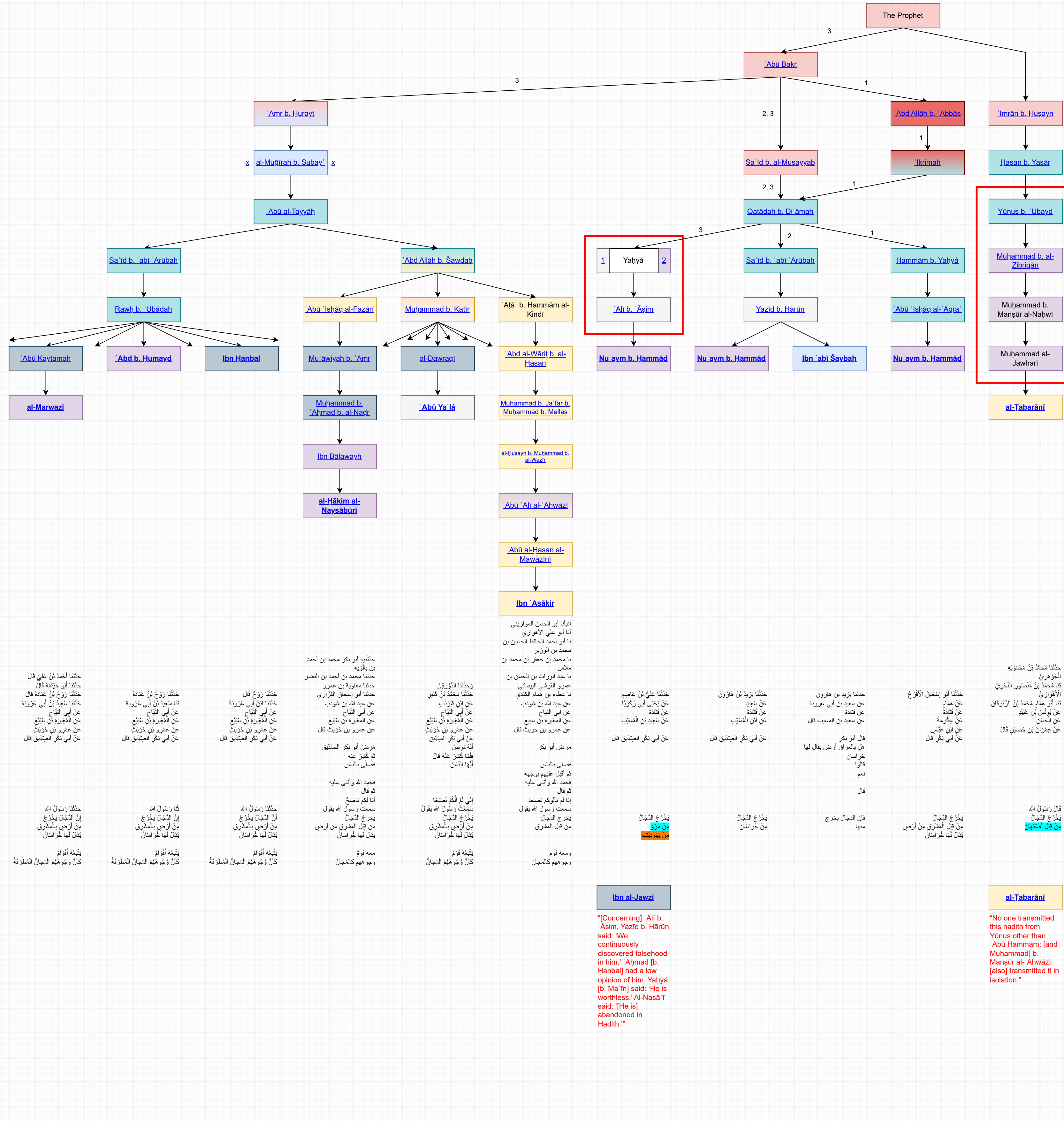
Ibn Hajar al-Asadani
 "Al-Darazi said in al-Ghara'ib... and Abd al-Samad was weak."

al-Dahabi (quoted by Ibn Mutaqqin)
 "Concerning the health of Ibn Umar, who (allegedly) said: 'I was with Hudayfah in the area near the Ka bah, then he mentioned a hadith, then he said: 'Assuredly, the bonds of Islam will be undone, one by one.'... The hadith (continues). He [i.e. al-Hakim al-Naysaburi] said: 'Sound: I say on the contrary, [it is] rejected, in it [is cited] Abd al-A. la b. Amir, whom Ahmad [b. Hanbal] deemed to be weak and Jahrim b. Abd Allah, who is reliable; and Muhammad b. Sinan, whom Abu Dawud deemed to be a liar.'"

Ibn Adi al-Qastlani
 "Al-Walid b. Abbād, [i.e. Ahmad b. Hanbal] transmitted from him [i.e. al-Walid b. Abbād] was [thus] unknown."

al-Nasa'i
 "Bahr b. Kantz al-Sadi was abandoned in Hadith."

 "Concerning Ali b. Asim, Yazid b. Harin said: 'We continuously discovered falsehood in him.'... Ahmad [b. Hanbal] had a low opinion of him, Yahya [b. Ma'in] said: 'He is worthless.'... Al-Nasa'i said: '[He is] abandoned in Hadith.'"

 "No one transmitted the hadith from Abu Hammam, [and] Muhammad b. Mansur [al-Ahwazi] transmitted it in isolation."

The Antichrist's donkey



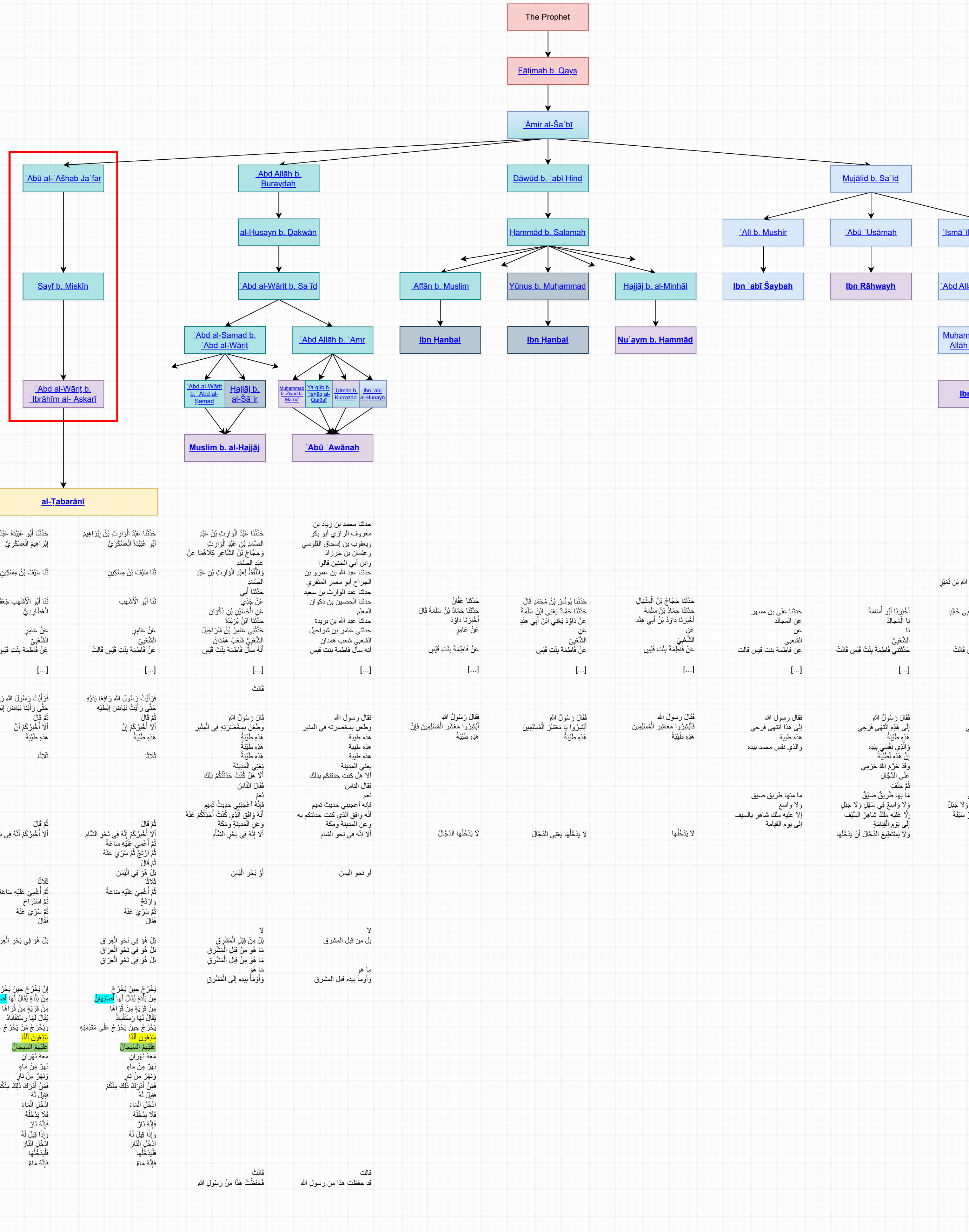
Abd al-Ghani al-Maqdisi
